

Ralph Kirsch Golden Pen Award

Professor Mike Machaba Sathekge, Head of the Department of Nuclear Medicine, University of Pretoria, and Steve Biko Academic Hospital was the inaugural recipient of the Ralph Kirsch Golden Pen Award created to recognise the most cited paper* in the Google Scholar Database published in the *SAMJ* in 2010.

This prize is associated with three institutions – Groote Schuur Hospital and the University of Cape Town through the Department of Medicine, and the South African Medical Association through the *SAMJ* – to which Ralph Kirsch dedicated his life.

The article has been cited in Russian and Chinese medical journals and research aggregator sites.
